Study Hall Specific Rules:

1. Do NOT touch anything on/in my desk, podium, computer, or cabinets without my permission!
 - a. Failure to follow this rule will result in immediate detention and parental contact.
2. When the opening bell rings, you must be SEATED in YOUR desk.
 - b. Failure to follow this rule will result in you being marked tardy or absent for the day.
3. You must be seated and absolutely quiet during all announcements.
4. Make sure your attire conforms to the dress code of St. Charles.
 - a. Anyone unable to meet the dress code will be referred to Mr. Lower.
5. Do not leave this classroom with ANY classroom textbooks.
 - a. Textbooks will be provided for your use during study hall.
6. Electronic devices, such as cell phones, iPods, and MP3 players will be confiscated and delivered to Mr. Lower.
 - a. Calculators being used as gaming devices will be confiscated.
7. Do not touch windows, blinds, fans, boards, or equipment without my permission.
8. Study hall is a SILENT study hall.
 - a. If you need to ask someone a question, ask my permission FIRST!
 - b. You must have my permission and a library pass before going to the library.
 - c. Discipline problems while you are in the library will be referred to me.
