Graduate Information: based on the state report for Ohio College Remediation Rates and the National Student Clearinghouse.

The Ohio Report for College Remediation Rates uses student data for college freshman who need to take remediation classes upon entering college at Ohio public two and four year colleges. The most recent data available is for the class of 2014:

* St. Charles students entering public colleges in Ohio from the Class of 2014 scored at the top 1% of all high schools in Ohio. Only 1% of students needed college level English remediation and 0% needed college level math remediation.

* Previous years in 2012 and 2013 showed students needed 0% remediation for English and 4% remediation for college level math.

The National Student Clearinghouse provides data about college persistence and completion rates. We have received our first reports from the NSC to gauge our student progress at college.

* The percent of students who returned to college for a second year (Freshman to Sophomore Persistence rate) for St. Charles averages 97% the past 6 years that data is available for. The most recent Class of 2013 persisted at a rate of 98%. The national average is 68%.
