**Final Grades.** Final grade cards were electronically mailed home yesterday.

**Summer school.** Summer school and work study will begin first thing Monday morning, **June 11**. Please see the attachment for detailed information on classes and times. All students were put in the classes and times for which parents registered. There will be a brief orientation for all boys taking summer classes and participating in Work Study at the 4 start times (8:00, 9:00, 10:00, and 11:00) on Monday morning. The Physical Education class will end on **Friday, June 29**. The last day for the other classes will be **Friday, July 6**. Reminder: the PSAT/Standardized Test Course is 2 weeks long. It runs from **June 11 through June 22**, from **10:00 – 1:00**.

Students participating in summer classes or work study should wear casual clothing. There is no cafeteria service during the summer. Boys that are here all day should plan to bring their lunch and drinks. Refrigerators will be available. Students should bring writing implements, a folder, and note paper to begin classes. If teachers need students to have other supplies, they will be told the first day of class.

**Tuition.** Tuition registration forms are due in the office by **Friday, June 15**. Any questions should be directed to Tracy Loesing in our finance office at 252-6714 ext. 25.

**Junior Parents.** Senior picture time is approaching. Prestige Portraits (formerly Cilento) is our official photographer for the senior picture composite and yearbook. They no longer have a studio for those photographing your sons. Instead, they have scheduled some days here at St. Charles to take those pictures. **Transportation.** St. Charles does not directly provide transportation to our students. There are several districts, however, that do bus to St. Charles. Please call your local school district transportation office to ask about their policies.

**Nurse notes.** Useful information and forms (blank physicals, state of Ohio immunization requirements, emergency and daily medication forms) are available under the nurses name (Midge Cull) on the St Charles website.

Physicals, including an immunization record, are required for every incoming freshman and transfer student. Then, yearly physicals are required only if your son is participating in a school sport. We use the OHSAA physical whether your son is participating in a sport or not.

Graduated senior parents – when your son turned in his cap and gown after graduation, he received a manila envelope containing his green health folder with immunization records and physicals.

If your incoming freshman son has any allergies or serious medical conditions and is attending Summer Readiness Classes, gym class or sports training, please contact the school nurse.

Incoming senior parents: According to Ohio Department of Health requirements, all students are required to have the MCV4 (meningitis) immunization(s) before starting their senior year of high school. Two doses of meningococcal MCV 4 vaccine must be administered prior to the start of the 2018 school year. ## ST. CHARLES SUMMER SCHOOL 2018

**Summer Readiness Classes.** Incoming freshmen at St. Charles have the opportunity to devote four weeks of the summer getting ready for the fall. The Summer Readiness Program for 2018 is scheduled from **June 11 – July 6**. Especially designed for students who anticipate some degree of difficulty in their freshman classes, the courses are geared toward the actual work that current 8th graders will face next school year. **Algebra I Readiness** prepares for Algebra I; **Latin I Readiness** prepares for Latin I; **Writing & Grammar Readiness** reinforces parts of speech as building blocks of the English language, understanding their functions in sentences, and writing purposeful sentences and paragraphs. The **Reading and Study Skills** course aims to address three areas: increasing reading comprehension, increasing the rate of speed of reading and finally, the development of study skills (note taking, outlining, etc.) which are critical in a college preparatory curriculum. If you are interested in any of these courses, please fill out the attached registration form and send it in as soon as possible. The cost is \$135 per class.

**Summer School Physical Education.** There will be one session of Physical Education offered this summer from **Monday, June 11 - Friday, June 29**. Information regarding registration is attached to this mailing. Please be aware that space is limited for this class. The cost is \$160. Since this course is for credit, students must be in attendance every day of the 3 week class.

**PSAT/Standardized Test Boot Camp.** This course is intended for PSAT and college-readiness remediation, but can also help any rising sophomore or junior prepare for the PSAT and SAT. Students will meet for two full weeks (**June 11-22, from 11 a.m.-2 p.m.**), learning test strategies and reviewing content. Students are expected to study nightly and attend class regularly. This class costs \$40 per student.

**Competency Tests.** The Algebra and Foreign Language competency tests for incoming freshmen will be given on **Thursday, June 7th and Friday, June 8th, from 9:00 – 10:30 a.m. or 1:00 – 2:30 p.m.** These tests are given to incoming freshmen who wish to place out of Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Latin I. Please call Laurie Berndt at 614-252-6714 in the main office between 9:00 – 4:00 to schedule the best time for your son to take the test(s).

**Regular Course Failures:** The following appears on page 16 of the St. Charles Preparatory Student Handbook: “No student will be admitted to school the following year unless, with the exception of elective courses, he has presented make up credits for failed or incomplete courses. The final grade listed on the student’s transcript for summer school makeup work is 60.”

Students who fail Latin I and/or Algebra I will take those courses at St. Charles. The registration form below should be sent to the main office. Those classes will run **from Monday, June 11 through Friday, July 6**.

Students with any other course failure must make up the credit through an approved, accredited high school course offered through a school district. It may be necessary to schedule two sessions in order to receive the full credit. A few public school districts will offer some courses this summer. **Generally speaking, the only unacceptable program would be with Columbus Public Schools.** Another option, typically less expensive, is with the BYU online high school course program. Your son would need to take both parts of a failed course(s). The following are the general **failed** courses being taken by St. Charles students through the BYU program. Arrangements for all out of school make up work must be made with the approval of the Academic Dean, Mr. John O’Neil.

**St. Charles will provide NHS tutors from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon for students taking the BYU courses. These tutors will be available on a daily basis from June 11 to July 6.**

Their Customer Service line is 1-800-914-8931 and Tech Support is 1-877-897-8085. Courses require on line assignment submissions, and a final exam (for each separate course) must be taken online at St. Charles under the supervision of certified BYU proctors. At least one course, Honors Chemistry, also requires a proctored mandatory mid-term exam be taken and passed, online, as well. Again, all final exams to

**complete BYU courses must be taken online. There will be a late July deadline for the assigned work and ordering the final exam.** The final course exam can be proctored in the first week of August if absolutely necessary. **Registering for the BYU program will require using the St. Charles College board testing ID number 361595.** Please contact Mr. O'Neil at [jooneil@cdeducation.org](mailto:jooneil@cdeducation.org) or 614.252.6714 after registering for the course.

St. Charles options include a 3 week summer course or scheduling PE during the school year for a semester. Students may also take summer physical education at an accredited high school offering either a .25 or .50 credit course.
