Update and Correction

**Formal Senior Photos:** Every graduating class has a formal composite picture produced by Prestige Portraits. If your son had formal photos completed by a photographer other than Prestige, he is still required to have a formal photo taken by Prestige. Prestige Portraits is available for final photos at their Gahanna location Thursday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> – Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>. To make an appointment for your son, please call **614-626- 8708**. Seniors must wear a dress shirt, tie, and dark sport coat for the photo. Students should wear their hair in accordance with the St. Charles dress code, and no facial hair is permitted. If you have any questions, please call the office.

**Graduation Packet:** If your senior has not received a packet from Herff-Jones through the U.S. mail, you can request one by calling **740-357-2160**.

The packet details items you can purchase for graduation. All items are discretionary; you are not required to order anything. **Please note:** You **do not** need to order **caps and gowns** because those are ordered by the main office.

## First-Semester Exams

**Exam Preparation:** As first semester exams draw nearer, it is very critical for students and families to remember the significance of those exams and the importance of serious and careful preparation. The semester exam for each academic course comprises twenty percent of the first-semester grade in the course.

**Conflict Exams:** Students needing to schedule conflict exams must see Mr. O’Neil in person. Conflict exams are primarily scheduled when a student has more than one class in the same subject area such as “doubling up” in sciences or foreign languages.

**Exam Plan:** Please note the following:

- All students must report to their testing sites by 8:20 a.m.
- All students begin their first exam at 8:30 a.m.
- After the first exam, the students stay in the testing center to study for the next exam. Students will bring snacks/drinks to the testing area.
- No cell phones can be used in the testing location before, after, or during testing.
- All **remote learners** will take their exams on campus in the afternoons of their test days; exact location to be determined.

**Nurses' Notes:** Every day we continue to follow best practices from our public health experts concerning hygiene, and health promotion. We appreciate all the reinforcement your sons receive at home supporting our requests for 6-foot spacing, face masks, handwashing and exceptional daily monitoring and reporting of their health status. We rely heavily on the honor system for health protection. Our goal is to safely stay in school. If there is any question about your son's health or safety in being in class with other students and teachers – please err on the side of caution and keep him at home. Any questions or considerations can be addressed to any administrator or the school nurses.

Please see the attached algorithm that we are using as a guideline for illnesses and when written/signed/dated health clearance by a health professional to return to school is required.

Siblings of students ill with suspect symptoms should follow exclusion recommendations until a diagnosis is made.
