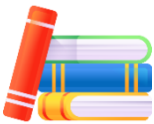

Book Pickup will take place in the Commons for Juniors and Seniors on Tuesday, August 17, and Freshmen and Sophomores on Wednesday, August 18. To receive textbooks, all documents in Final Forms must be completed and signed by a parent and the student.

Additionally, students are asked to do the following when coming in for textbooks:


- Pick up their device
- Complete a vision test if they are an incoming student
- Confirm our receipt of any outstanding physicals and health information
- Confirm tuition payment plans have been finalized


In addition to multiple steps in this process, your student may encounter lines at the different stations. Please plan enough time for your son(s) to complete this visit.

The information includes blank physicals, the State of Ohio immunization requirements, and emergency and daily medication forms.</p> <p>COVID-19 vaccine clinic information is available through the following sites. Emails have been sent to those seniors who still need to submit the MCV 4 vaccine information. (Keep in mind that the COVID vaccine needs to have a minimum of a two-week interval between any other vaccine.)</p> <p>All new incoming students (freshmen and transfer students) are required to submit a current physical and immunization record. After the first physical is submitted, yearly physicals are only required if the student is participating in sports or activities at St Charles. <p><i>'21-'22 Bus Transportation</i></p> 	<p>Families interested in school bus transportation should visit their respective public-school district website. Select the transportation department page to see if service might be available from your area to St. Charles. For districts which do not offer busing to the school, resident parents may apply to the school district transportation division for Payment In-Lieu to receive some financial reimbursement for the expense of transporting their own child[ren] to a non-district or private school. Deadlines for these applications are generally during the summer preceding the school year. Whether applying for busing or Payment In-Lieu, application deadlines for the 2021-2022 school year may be in the coming weeks. So, check your public-school district's website soon!</p>
<p><i>Dress Code</i></p> 	<p>Dress and grooming. Good grooming should be a mark of every St. Charles student. Students are expected to avoid extremes in clothing and hair styles. Neck jewelry, bracelets, and earrings are not permitted.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are required to be clean shaven. Hair and sideburns must be kept neat, combed, brushed, clean, and trimmed, not covering their ears or shirt collar. Beards, mustaches, and tinted or dyed hair, are not permitted. The judgment of the Dean of Students is final in these matters. 2. A dress shirt with a collar that buttons down the front and is tucked in, a tie, dress pants of appropriate length with a belt, and brown or black leather dress shoes with socks are to be worn to class. During August, September, May, and June, the tie is optional, and a polo/golf shirt is permitted. During the cooler months, a sweater, a St. Charles letter jacket, or St. Charles apparel approved by the Dean of Students may be worn to class. Dressing for warmth must not detract from or impede the student's formal appearance; the shirt collar and tie must be visible. The judgment of the Dean of Students is final in these matters. 3. Denim jeans, shirts, and jackets of any color, flannel or corduroy shirts, cargo pants, painter pants, carpenter pants, any type of athletic shoes, slippers, work boots, hooded apparel, sweatshirts not related to St. Charles, shirts with advertisements or labels, or college or professional sports apparel, are not acceptable for regular classes. The judgment of the Dean of Students is final in these matters.
<p><i>Devices</i></p> 	<p>The use of mobile phones, smartphones, and smart watches is not permitted during the school day. Students are not permitted to use cell phones to record video/audio at any time. Students are not permitted to connect these devices to the school's network. Violation of these policies may lead to the following consequences: confiscation of the device, detentions, suspensions, or the student may be asked to withdraw.</p>
<p><i>Work Permits</i></p> 	<p>If your son obtains a job, he should be given the Ohio Minor Work Permit form by his employer. You must complete the Student/Applicant Information section and return the form to the main office this summer. During the school year, however, Miss Smith in Guidance processes Work Permit requests.</p>
